Stay Safe at ATMs

Occurrences of ATM skimming were up 546% in 2015 and are expected to continue to rise.

Card skimming (or ATM skimming) is when a fraudster illegally copies your debit or credit card data from the magnetic strip on your debit or credit card when you use your card. A hidden camera is also setup to capture your P.I.N. (Personal Identification Number) as you enter it

The details copied from your card are then copied onto a blank debit or credit card creating an exact duplicate or clone.

That cloned card can then be used by the fraudster to make fraudulent transactions using the P.I.N. captured with the hidden camera.

Stay safe by using your other hand to shield the view of entering your P.I.N. This way, the cameras won't be able to see the P.I.N you're entering.

If you suspect a skimmer on a machine, contact the financial institution or ATM owner or the police, immediately.
